





Background: about accelerators

- New model of investing into startups shaped mainly by Ycombinator (founded in 2005) in Silicon Valley and TechStars (2006) in Boulder, Colorado
- ~ 200 major startup accelerators in the world
- Key players:
 - Y Combinator, 500 Startups (US), TechStars (US, UK), Seedcamp (UK)
- Few focused on hardware startups:
 - Bolt (US), Haxlr8r (China), Lemnos Lab (US), Highway1 (US), Industrio (Italy)
- Even fewer on creative industries:
 - Creative Startups Accelerator (US), Creative England Digital Accelerator (UK), CreatiFI (FIN)




- 300+ applications from 50+ countries

Creative Industries




Creative Industries


Why such focus?

- High potential for new innovative products in the creative industries with high speed-to-market
- Wearable market to grow at a compound annual rate of 35% over the next five years, reaching 148 million units shipped annually in 2019, up from 33 million units shipped in 2014





Sensition helps production camera crews to keep the camera picture in focus on complex scenes where focus.pulling is beyond normal human capabilities.





Selection process

100+ applications evaluated on F6S.org by Buildit's team and mentors

Ca. 15 teams on to a panel consisting of startup, hardware, CCI and investment experts

F6S.org Skype Panel Final selection

Ca. 30 applicants called forward to a 30min Skype interview with Buildit's team

Up to 10 companies selected for the programme

Programme

- 3 months of mentoring, product development and customer discovery
- Up to 25k EUR investment per startup for up to 12% equity
- Possible follow-up investment up to 20k EUR into best performing teams
- Targeting European startups but accepting strong applicants globally
- Up to 10 startups in each batch
- The next 4 batches are running:

Sept – Dec 15, March – June 16, Sept – Dec 16, March – June 170



Programme includes

- Discounted services and free offerings from partners like Altium, Google, Microsoft etc.
- Open office during the program + 3 extra months at Tartu Science Park, prototyping facilities, small scale production in cooperation with strategic partners
- Investor network in EU and US
- Manufacturing partners in Estonia (small-scale), China and Taiwan (large-scale)
