METHODS IN THE INSPIRATION ROOM

- Continuity, as often as possible, most groups once per month.
- Themes in the Inspiration-room.
- Oral storytelling
- Children´s picture books
- "Lamp-reading"
- Massage stories
- Handpuppets
- Pause-gymnastics related to the book
- Songs and clap-rhytms related to the theme.
- Projects for boys, to increase their reading.
- Diplomas for the whole school.



MAGIC

The reading aloud must not only be good, it needs to be PERFECT

- Must catch the audience from the first sentence
- The reader must have chosen the book carefully, really personally like it and have rehearsed it
- Presence
- Surroundings, must have been planned.
- Magical elements to arouse the expectations. The stone of silece, the bottles wth feelings


M+M+M PERFECTION = READER

10 Steps toward Reading Inspiration.

Reading is for life ! How does one become a Reader? Which advantages does a reader have? How does a Reader function in society? Everyday life is a home in which readers are born. Books provide us with endless opportunities every day.

Becoming an avid Reader includes the stages Beginner, Gobbler and Chooser. In the beginning the child learns to decode, needs to be familiar with words and must be MOTIVATED. A job for everybody working with children before they attend school.

3. The professional educators shall read the best of literature pedagogically and artistically as well as have a plan for inspiring children to read. They should read with knowledge, sound judgement, great inspiration and a heart that beats for the good of the children

•4. The physical room – environment for book education.Create expectation! How to accommodate groups and how to do it well. 5. The experience – a gift where all senses are activated. The book moment is planned, rehearsed and contains goals and meaning. The professional book moment contains something for the eyes, ears, heart and the whole body.



6. Methods and magic – storytelling, the art of reading aloud, flashlight and massage tales 7. The important choice – THE BOOK. Choose with care and knowledge! Trust your own judgment and adjust to your audience



8. Heart – tolerance and affirmation. The listener should always leave a book session empowered, comforted and wanting more



9. Cooperation and fresh thinking between homes, schools and libraries. The Hanko model, projects and campaigns



10. The future and the vision of the new way of working in libraries.


