






World Bank Report on Latvia Disability Policy

- Reality of the future significant fraction of the population will be elderly, many of whom will be experiencing disability
- Importance of health care and social sector interactions and electronic data exchange
- > Standardized assessment tools (WHODAS) should be used to assess limitations in activities and restrictions in participation
- > The integrated service provision model
- Adding a needs assessment to disability assessment
