



Personal assistance

Personal assistance was regulated in The Law on the Social Integration of PWD in 2021

- > In 2021 568 service users
- ➤ In 2022 1534 (estimated service users)
- > 810 service users funden by ES (until 2022)

Assistance in social contacts

Individual discreet assistance

Accessibility of the physical, information environment, products and services

The core aims are:

- 1. to increase the quality of life index for people with disabilities from 48 % to 60 % by 2030;
- 2. to ensure accessibility of the physical environment from 30 % to 70 %;
- 3. and to ensure that information infrastructure and information are adapted to the needs of people with disabilities from 5 % to 50 %.

Changes in the attitudes of employers, the working environment and society


Deinstitutionalization

Main activities:


- √ mapping;

- √ Attitudes towards people with disabilities in all sectors




Reform of the institute of incapacity



One stop shop: children with disability and their families


The aim - implementation of "Child guarantee" system in Lithuania



Temporary respite


In Lithuania the temporary respite services was regulated in the Catalog of Social Services in 2019

In order to increase the availability of the service, amendments to the Law on Social Services are envisaged, which will allow the provision of temporary respite service to individuals.
