1. No gender based violence (This is given priority in the 10 November Conference in the House of Europe in Stockholm)
2. No gender based discrimination
3. No structural inequalities between women and men

**SKENs announcement from the November**

**conference are the following five statements:**

**1. The home is still the most dangerous place for women**

**2.The perpetrator should be removed from home not the victim**



**3. the perpetrator should not be permitted to meet alone the child/children**

**4. it is important to support the victim and keep the perpetrator accountable**

**5. the decision makers, courts and experts need to listen more to the women and children**

The Swedish Government presented 99 items February 2022  
to be implemented 2022-2023

including to

prevent violence against women as well as

increase the support for the victims.

**Even changes in the law legislation is included.**

In Sweden this year 2022 (January-May)  
twenty (20) women being killed by a  
person in their near relation

This takes place in our country **the most  
equal country !**

This I refer to with “forgotten gender  
equality problem” .

We got very happy when we learned about the **Latvian legislation** where the perpetrator has to leave the home and the victim stay.

We (SKEN) are now lobbying in the Swedish Parliament ( the Justice and Labor departments) for learning about the Latvian legislation and its effect when implemented.

— *We expericence that we are less alone after two conferences  
and three zoom meetings. We can certainly achieve more  
together - we can change the world!*
