Transnational dimention of the project

- Law enforcement investigations indicate that Lithuania is a source country for Norway being a country of destination.
- Targets are mainly vulnerable persons who are transported from Lithuania to Norway and organized criminal groups from Lithuania.
- Almost all known victims were transported and exploited for sexual service and petty crimes.
- Analysis of the fact of THB shows that Lithuanian organized criminal groups play an active role in the organization and trafficking in human beings in Scandinavian countries.



Objectives to be reached

- To exchange the newest modi operandi on THB.
- To combine and collect data in order to identify the persons who have been the organizers in individual cases using the similar modi operandi.
- To identify potential traffickers and their victims
- Strenght cooperation between Lithuanian and Norwegian THB investigation unit.
- Informal exchange of information



Evaluation of the situation

- Rapid and informal exchange of information concerning THB victims and suspects.
- Gathering and analyses of obtained intelligence data.
- Common operational activities based on intelligence data.
- Each member state will work out investigations independently or a JIT (Joint Investigation Team) will be established if necessary.
