Tallinn Business Incubators Foundation

TBI founded by Tallinn City Council on the 18 May 2006

Tallinn City Enterprise Board started the incubation project in 2002



Concept of the foundation

- A business incubator is a small business support measure to accelerate the growth and improve the success rate of entrepreneurial start-ups through:
- > minimizing entrepreneurial risks;
- increasing competitiveness;
- In growing innovation capacity and cooperation abilities.



Funding of the foundation

Financed by the city of Tallinn

Total budget for 2008 – about 400,000 EUR

- → ~ 350,000 EUR from Tallinn City budget
- > ~ 50,000 EUR direct income (rent, services)
- Total investment by the city of Tallinn in 2002– 2007 is about 1,04 mil EUR
 - Investment for Creative Incubator in 2008 500,000 EUR



Incubator's objectives

- Survival degree of 90%
- Turnover growth
- Profit utility
- High rate of value added
- New job creation
- Synergic environment



Business Incubators in Tallinn?

- Ülemiste Business Incubator (Suur-Sõjamäe 10A)
 - started operating in 2003, expanded at the end of 2006, up to 25 companies
- Kopli Business Incubator (Kopli 98)
 Started operating in 2004 up to 30 companies
 - started operating in 2004, up to 30 companies
- Creative Incubator (Niine 11)
 - will be opened in 2009

Idea of the creative incubator

Studio-like environment with the aim to boost creative industry



Purpose of the creative incubator

- Raising the competitiveness and sustainability of creative industry enterprises.
- Increasing of the number of creative industry enterprises, enlivening and diversification of creative environment.
- Making different districts of Tallinn more attractive by means of creative industry centers.



Advantages of Kalamaja

- District accepted by creative individuals
- Closeness of Old Town (services, entertainment, galleries, stores)
- Fast development of Northern Tallinn district (Skoone bastion, Kultuurikatel)
- Community of creative individuals located in the building (architecture and interior decoration companies, media enterprises, photographers studio, etc)
- Niine 11 has a potential to become a creative cluster









Creative incubator's space arrangement

- Overall surface area is 1000 m² including:
 - ✓10 offices 15-30 m²
 - ✓9 studios 25-70 m²
 - Kitchen
 - Lounge
 - Meeting rooms



Office and infrastructure possibilities

Office space

- Studios, equipped offices and workspaces, meeting rooms (shared administrative costs)
- Secretary services
- ブ IT
 - Computers, internet connection (incl. Wi-Fi), servers, individual telephone number



Services possibilities

- Initial analysis of business idea, market potential, crash course in entrepreneurship
- Financial consulting, specialized courses on relevant topics
- Constant monitoring of company performance during incubation
- Assistance in finding partners and organizing public relations
- Information on funding possibilities, conferences, fairs, and support organizations
- Assistance in composing projects and finding funding



Services offered by the creative incubator

- Manager services (supply of raw materials, product sales, exhibitions, fairs, and other)
- Legal consultation intellectual property rights, law of obligations and other
- Accounting consultations
- Services by incubator's partner companies (printing and copying center)
- Other services depending on the need of tenantcompanies



How to become a tenant



Company specifications

- not more than 2 years from registration
- registered and located in Tallinn
- Up to 10 employees
- no tax arrears
- no bankruptcy or liquidation proceedings going on
