# Integration challenges from previous migration flows?

European societies and cities have changed

- Different paths of strcutrual integration: housing and labour markets as well as intermarriages
- Policy emphasis on social and economic (language, education, labour market)
- Less emphasis on cross-group networks and firsthand encounters at different life domains -> Vejle case a good example of contradictions

Return to terms previously lost for political correctness: ethnic hierarchies

# New challenges that come along with the ongoing migration crisis?

- Figures are huge: e.g. the number of last years asylum seekers equals the population size of Pärnu
- The debate about generic vs individualized approach to integration
- The educational qualifications of the migrants is a huge challenge
- Research of all sorts of social outcomes provides a clear signal: outcomes are predicted by education
- Policy focus: education in orgin countries undergoing demographic transition

#### How we as experts answer to the question that are in the minds of the general public?

People living their daily lives, employers, policymakers -> all lone despetately advise

How to answer to the big questions such as: Has integration been a success or a failure?

- I do not know
- Break down such big questions into smaller and answerable ones?
- Break down the big questions into smaller and answerable ones AND keep an eye on these big questions?
