What Is The Fuzz About?

- Large-scale emigration may destabilize society
 - Does the "exodus from rural areas" repeat at EU level?
 - People are productivity: dense areas more developed
- Are minorities more willing to move?
 - Attachment to the country (Constant & Massey 2003, Aptekar 2009)
 - (Perceived) discrimination
 - Earn less (Leping & Toomet 2008)
 - Language skills
- Should the policy target minorities?

- Migration as investment (Sjaastaad 1962)
 - Young move . . .
 - ...toward high salary
- High-skilled leaving . . .
 - ...if return higher abroad (Borjas 1994)
- Language skills important (Adsera, Pytlikova 2013)
- Social networks matter (Carrington et al 1996, Pedersen et al 2008)
 - Too few Estonian-speakers abroad?
 - A lot more Russian-speakers
- Re-emigration of immigrants (Borjas & Bratsberg 1996)
 - Worst-of-the-best
 - Best-of-the-worst
 - Russian speakers do not return (Anniste & Tammaru 2013)

- Look at Labor Migration Survey 2000-2013
 - 6500 obs
- Compare ethnic Estonians/Others (Russians)
 - Reasons to move/stay
 - Preferred country
 - Background effects
- Find:
 - Russians more inclined to emigrate
 - But only up to 2010
 - Estonians prefer Finland and Sweden
 - Country-specific identity rather similar






Why This Country?
